All monthly packages include the initial lesson for new students. Lessons must be taken within the single calendar month for which they were purchased. Payment is accepted on a monthly basis only. Eight or twelve lessons may be split between family members. Normal lessons are 60 minutes long and limited to groups of five riders or less. Initial lessons are longer, and are usually private or semi-private. Private lessons average 45 minutes. Grasshopper lessons are 30 minutes long, and are only for very young or very unfit horses or riders.

Lessons that must be cancelled by the instructor will be made up during the calendar month -- or in the case of inclement weather or severe scheduling restrictions, before the 10th of the next calendar month. The student is not penalized for lessons cancelled by the instructor or rescheduled due to inclement weather.

**No-shows and lessons cancelled by the student with less than 24 hours notice for reasons other than emergencies will be forfeited. Refunds are not given under any circumstances.**

**Lesson Rules and Guidelines: Riders must wear proper riding attire: boots, riding pants, and helmet. Hair is to be neatly tied back. Tops should be modest and well-fitting. Loose or baggy clothing, jewelry, and chewing gum are safety hazards and are not permitted. Riders are expected to arrive promptly for lessons. Those who are able to get horses out, groom, tack up and/or warm up independently are expected to have done so before instruction begins.**
